

Since the first of September, the Fennville District Library has been utilizing a portion of the grant awarded by the <u>The American Library Association</u> COVID Library Relief Fund to build a core collection of Spanish and bilingual materials. Over 500 literary resources for all ages have been added to our collection and are now available for public circulation. All collections include new fiction and non-fiction titles, from board books to graphic novels.

Books for children and youth can be found in our Youth Services department. On the main floor, you can find materials for Young Adults, and Adults. On pages 4 and 5 of the newsletter, you will find links to a handful of the authors we have added. With this addition to our collection the Fennville District Library continues to maintain its mission "to provide access to varied materials and services for lifelong enrichment."





most visionary in America: Grandson of the first Ford; Henry Ford II; influential labor leader Walter Reuther; Motown's founder Berry Gordy; the Reverend C.L. Franklin and his daughter, the amazing Aretha; Governor George Romney, Mormon and Civil Rights advocate; super car salesman Lee Iacocca; Mayor Jerome Cavanagh, a Kennedy acolyte; Police Commissioner George Edwards; Martin Luther King. It was the American auto makers' best year; the revolution in music and politics was underway. Reuther's UAW had helped lift the middle class.

The time was full of promise. The auto industry was selling more cars than ever before and inventing the Mustang. Motown was capturing the world with its amazing artists. The progressive labor movement was rooted in Detroit with the UAW. Martin Luther King delivered his "I Have a Dream" speech there two months before he made it famous in the Washington march.

Once in a Great City shows that the shadows of collapse were evident even then. Before the devastating riot. Before the decades of civic corruption and neglect, and white flight. Before people trotted out the grab bag of rust belt infirmities—from harsh weather to high labor costs—and competition from abroad to explain Detroit's collapse.
