- LEO community grant celebration: June 27th is being proposed for a city-wide celebration including parade, music, and other activities. It was suggested that we should have a ribbon-cutting ceremony when the parking lot opens this Fall.
- Trane is upgrading our system which is 97% complete and just needs slight addition.
