-Abi applied to the CMU Clarke Memorial Library's Digital Michigan Newspaper Grant program for a grant to have our Fennville Herald archives digitized. We won!

Copies of the Herald from 1941 – 1956 will be digitized and housed at the Clarke website.

-We will have a Pay-It-Forward opportunity in the library again in April. A library patron has once again offered a matching funds challenge.

-Parking Lot financing: details on separate page attached. Do we want to also do a fundraiser? The board's response is 'yes!' Fundraiser involvement increases ownership in the community. Teresa, Becky and Jodi will gather ideas.

-The library has received a donation of paintings by Bruce Cascia with the directive they can be sold for the library's benefit. Teresa has sought advice from other libraries and a silent auction seems to be the best option.

-We have a painting on display in the library by Louis Ritman. Teresa will look into having it appraised as some of his paintings are quite valuable.

-Beautify Pullman: Teresa met with representatives of the group to discuss options for serving the Pullman population better. They have decided not to pursue having their own library. Options for a book vending machine were presented and will be explored.
